COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

DR. JERRY E. MCGEE

President Emeritus of Wingate University and Special Assistant to the President, Pfeiffer University



Dr. Jerry E. McGee, a native of Rockingham, North Carolina, received his undergraduate degree from East Carolina University. He also holds a master's degree from Appalachian State University and a doctorate from Nova Southeastern University. Dr. McGee enjoyed much success during his 41 years in higher education, securing more than \$350 million in gifts and grants for scholarships, endowments, and campus development.

Dr. McGee's service as Vice President of Gardner-Webb University, Meredith College, and Furman University prepared him well for the position of President of Wingate University, which he assumed in 1992. Under his visionary leadership, Wingate University gained routine recognition as one of the best small universities in the South and the premier small private university in North Carolina.

Throughout his presidency at Wingate, Dr. McGee implemented various initiatives, such as developing graduate programs, achieving University status, launching a School of Pharmacy, tripling enrollment, and adding 37 new campus facilities. As a result of his leadership, the institution became a doctoral-granting university. Dr. McGee's tenure spanned many years, culminating in his retirement in 2015, making him the most extended-serving college or university president in the Carolinas. In recognition of his contributions, he was bestowed the title of President Emeritus upon retirement.

Dr. McGee's illustrious career has earned him a place in several prominent halls of fame, including the North Carolina Sports Hall of Fame and various education and business halls of fame. The Order of the Long Leaf Pine, North Carolina's most prestigious civilian award, was bestowed upon him for his exceptional service to the state.

Dr. McGee has two sons: Ryan, a graduate of the University of Tennessee, a senior writer and television host for ESPN, and Sam, a graduate of Wake Forest University and Yale Law School, a practicing attorney. He is a proud grandparent to Tara, Hannah, and Brooks McGee. Dr. McGee was previously married to Hannah Covington McGee for 33 years until her passing in 1999 and later remarried to Marcella McInnis in 2009.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The formal academic dress worn today originated more than 600 years ago. The apparel has changed little in appearance but has taken on a significant role in identifying the degree and alma mater of its wearer.

Gowns for those with bachelor's degrees have pointed sleeves; those with master's degrees wear oblong sleeves and holders of doctoral degrees wear bell-shaped sleeves. Doctoral gowns have velvet facing on the front and three velvet stripes on each side. Hoods indicate the colors of the institution from which the degree was received and the color of the hood's border represents the academic discipline in which the degree was earned.
